Arrival

Arriving on **Tuesday**: a representative of SO HSS will be waiting you at the *Zagreb airport and Zagreb bus station* to direct you to hotel with shuttle/public transport. If you need assistance feel free to call **emergency contact**. At the arrival to the hotel, you will be greeted by somebody and registered.

If you arriving **later or before Tuesday**:

From airport: use shuttle which will drive you to bus station. (Price cca. 30 kn, around €4)

Exit the **bus station**; take the tram nr.6 or nr.2 moving towards right (you must be facing the bus station). Drive for 3 stops and exit in front of **train station**. Continue in same direction using instructions below (do not buy new ticket).

From the **train station**: after you exit train station, cross small street, take the tram number 9 moving towards your right - LJUBLJANICA- (you must be facing train station and big statue is behind your back). Drive to station BADALIĆEVA (just after the big glass business tower CIBONA), take the first street towards right and hotel is after cca. 100 meters on the left side.

Ticket for tram is around €1,2. You can buy tickets in older trams from the driver and newspaper stands (kiosks) for cash. In the new trams, you can't buy tickets, but you can pay them on installed yellow devices with credit card.



Hotel Accommodation

Participants will be accommodated in a three star Hotel Laguna. Hotel facilitates free parking for guests of hotel and free WiFi in all rooms.

Language, currency, time

- Croatian (Hrvatski); most of the people can speak at least basic English (younger population) and German (older population)
- Official currency is Kuna (HRK); 1€ = 7,5 kn (approximately); Credit cards are accepted almost everywhere but are not common in bars and nightclubs; tips are not part of the culture but customers usually round up on higher value (9,73 = 10)
- Croatia is in Central European Time Zone, (GMT +1)

Weather

This winter is colder than usual, at the moment (11 days before the event) we are experiencing temperatures below -15°C. Whole February is going to be cold and snowy. Please check the weather forecast a day before your trip.
